LAUSD requirements for culmination:

- In 8th grade, students will earn 5 credits for each semester course in Math, Science, English/ELD, Social Studies, PE, and Elective with a mark of "D" or better.
- Students must earn 50 out of the possible 60 Credits at the end of the 8th grade year to receive the Certificate of Completion.

No more than 2 Fails for the entire 8th grade year.





Eligibility for 8th grade Activities:

Grade eligible from Fall Final Report Card and 15 week Spring Report Card: Students will earn 5 credits for each semester course in Math, Science, English/ELD, Social Studies, PE, and Elective with a mark of "D" or better.

U's in Work Habits and Cooperation:

No more than two 'Us' in Cooperation and no more than two 'Us' in Work Habits as part of the FINAL grades issued on the Fall report card and the 15 week progress report in the Spring.

8th Grade Activities Cligibility

Continued Eligibility for 8th grade Activities:

Discipline violations:

Frequent or serious violations of school regulations may disqualify a student from participating in 8th grade activities.

Attendance:

Maintain an attendance rate of 96% or higher. No more than 7 absences during the entire school year.










Mnderstanding High School Courses Planning




what are 4-G Courses?

A-G refers to the seven academic subject areas that high school students are required to pass with a grade of "C" or better to be eligible for UC and CSU admission.

The A-G curriculum comprises core subjects and elective courses that involve substantial reading, writing, problem solving and laboratory work (as appropriate), and show serious attention to analytical thinking, factual content and development of students' oral and listening skills.

Students who have successfully met A-G requirements have attained a body of general knowledge that will provide breadth and perspective to the new, more advanced demands of college coursework and rewarding careers in the 21st century.








LAUSD "A-G" Requirements








- For the purpose of graduation, LAUSD follows the rules used by the California State University (CSU) to determine if students have met the A-G requirements.
- LAUSD will accept grades of **D** or better to satisfy the A-G requirements for graduation
- UC and CSU require students to pass the A-G requirements with a C or better for admission


