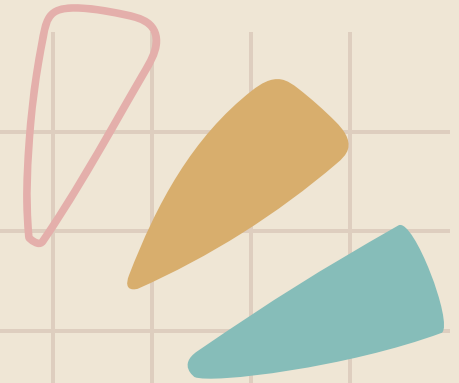

LAUSD requirements for culmination:



In 8th grade, students will earn 5 credits for each semester course in Math, Science, English/ELD, Social Studies, PE, and Elective with a mark of "D" or better.



Students must earn 50 out of the possible 60 Credits at the end of the 8th grade year to receive the Certificate of Completion.



No more than 2 Fails for the entire 8th grade year.

8th Grade Activities Eligibility

Eligibility for 8th grade Activities:

- ✂ Grade eligible from Fall Final Report Card and 15 week Spring Report Card: Students will earn 5 credits for each semester course in Math, Science, English/ELD, Social Studies, PE, and Elective with a mark of "D" or better.
- ✂ U's in Work Habits and Cooperation:
No more than two 'Us' in Cooperation and no more than two 'Us' in Work Habits as part of the FINAL grades issued on the Fall report card and the 15 week progress report in the Spring.

8th Grade Activities Eligibility

Continued Eligibility for 8th grade Activities:



Discipline violations:

Frequent or serious violations of school regulations may disqualify a student from participating in 8th grade activities.



Attendance:

Maintain an attendance rate of 96% or higher. No more than 7 absences during the entire school year.

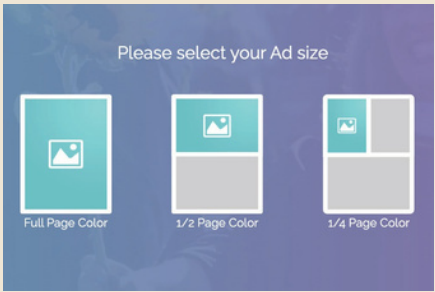

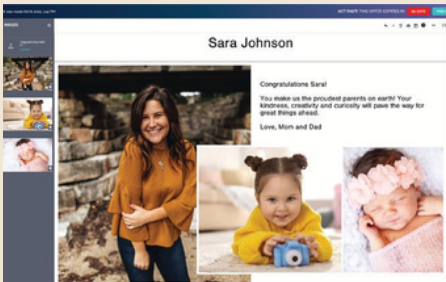

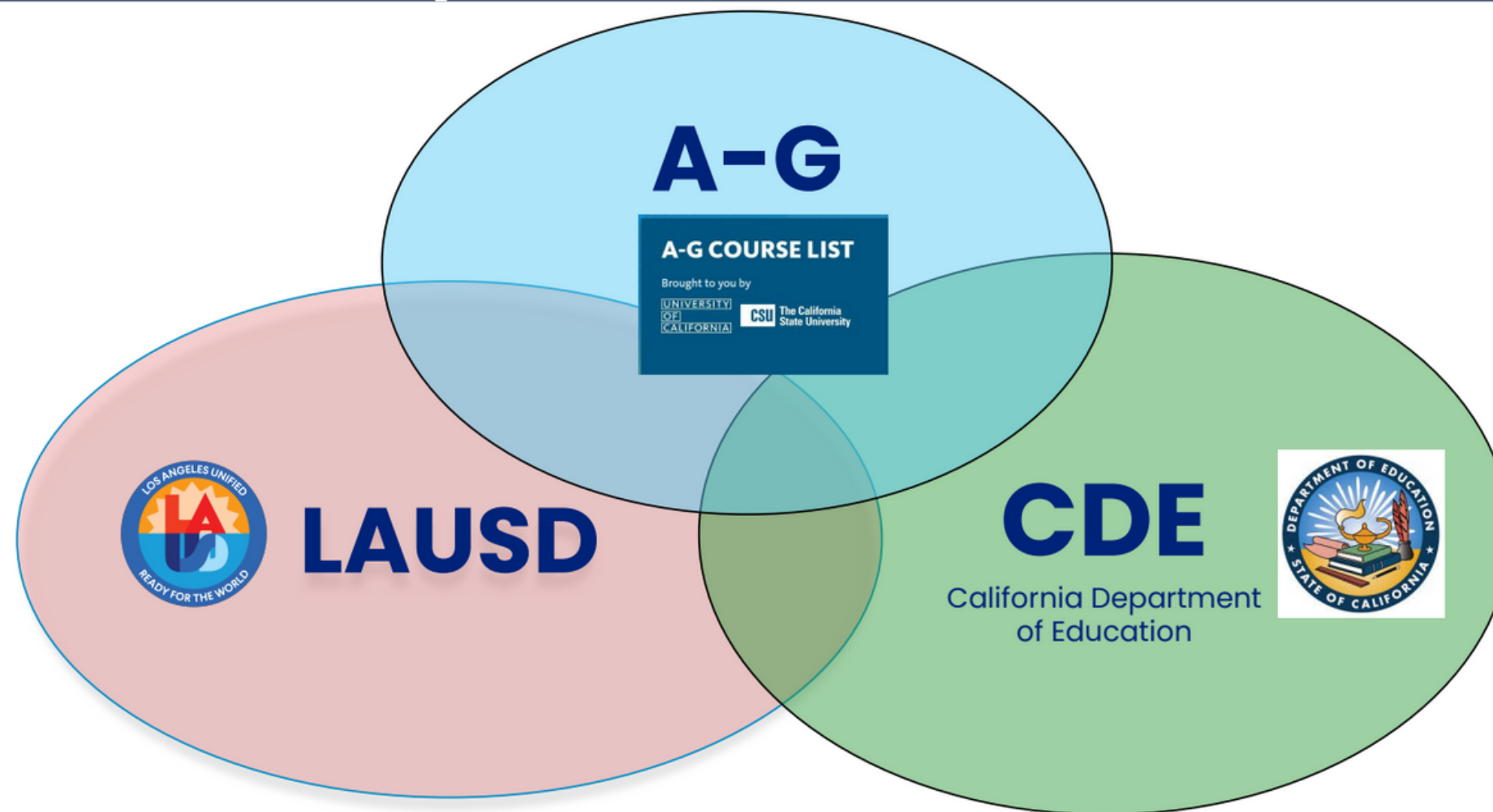

Understanding High School Courses Planning

The District remains committed to providing a quality education for every student in a safe, caring environment and providing pathways to ensure students graduate college and career ready. LAUSD has set the graduation requirements for the Class of 2022 and beyond to include: "A-G" course sequence that aligns with the minimum "A-G" course sequence requirements for California State Universities, the California Department of Education course requirements, and other LAUSD course and non-course requirements. - *From LAUSD website, A-G Requirements*

What are A-G Courses?

A-G refers to the seven academic subject areas that high school students are required to pass with a grade of "C" or better to be eligible for UC and CSU admission.

The A-G curriculum comprises core subjects and elective courses that involve substantial reading, writing, problem solving and laboratory work (as appropriate), and show serious attention to analytical thinking, factual content and development of students' oral and listening skills.

Students who have successfully met A-G requirements have attained a body of general knowledge that will provide breadth and perspective to the new, more advanced demands of college coursework and rewarding careers in the 21st century.

A-G Requirement

THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED WITH A "C" OR BETTER IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ENROLLMENT IN A UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA OR CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY:

- A** HISTORY/ SOCIAL SCIENCE | 3 YEARS | 
- B** ENGLISH | 4 YEARS | 
- C** MATHEMATICS | 3 YEARS | 
- D** LABORATORY SCIENCE | 2 YEARS | 
- E** LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH | 2 YEARS | 
- F** VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS | 1 YEAR | 
- G** COLLEGE PREPARATORY ELECTIVE | 1 YEAR |

LAUSD "A-G" Requirements

- For the purpose of graduation, LAUSD follows the rules used by the California State University (CSU) to determine if students have met the A-G requirements.
- LAUSD will accept grades of **D or better** to satisfy the A-G requirements for graduation
- UC and CSU require students to pass the A-G requirements with a **C or better** for admission

CSU VS UC

A HISTORY/SOCIAL SCIENCE

2 years of History/Social Science, including 1 year of U.S. History or U.S. History and Principles of American Democracy and 1 year of an additional approved Social Science course



2 years of History/Social Science, including 1 year of World History and 1 year of U.S. History or one-half year of U.S. History and one-half year of Principles of American Democracy

B ENGLISH

4 years of college preparatory English courses



4 years of college preparatory English courses

C MATHEMATICS

3 years of college preparatory mathematics including Algebra 1 and 2 and Geometry. A 4th year is recommended



3 years of college preparatory mathematics including Algebra 1 and 2 and Geometry. A 4th year is recommended

D LABORATORY SCIENCE

2 years of Laboratory Science, including 1 year of Biological Science and 1 year of Physical Science with lab



2 years of Laboratory Science, 3 years is recommended; Biology and Chemistry or Physics

E LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH

2 years of the same Language Other Than English
